


SEAL Team 6 Turns Saturdays Into Scholar Days

Bloomfield Mourns the Loss of Hall of Famer and Legendary Coach F. **James White**

It is with great sadness that we report the passing of F. James White, a Bloomfield High School Athletic Hall of Famer and legendary coach, on Sunday, March 9, 2019.

White, a 1954 Bloomfield High School graduate, led the Bengals to countless Championships in Boys Soccer, Girls Basketball, and Track and Field. Appointed Head Coach for the Bengals girls varsity basketball team in

teams. The 1988-89 squad was led by the very talented Jennifer Lipinski and Laura Leacy and Dana Morton, who was named All-Essex County and All-State First Team, and became Bloomfield's first female 1,000-point scorer. He had a remarkable record of 28-4. Overall, White won hundreds of games for Bengals Soccer and Lady Bengals Basketball, with a combined record of 665-251-57.


