Bloomfield Mourns the Loss of Hall of Famer and Legendary Coach F. James White



It is with great sadness that we report the passing of F. James White, a Bloomfield High School Athletic Hall of Famer and legendary coach, on Sunday, March 9, 2019.

White, a 1954 Bloomfield High School graduate, led the Bengals to countless Championships in Boys Soccer, Girls Basketball, and Track and Field. Appointed Head Coach for the Bengals girls varsity basketball team in 1981, he has an overall average of 148-56 and coached three New Jersey Section II-Group IV Championship teams. The 1988-89 squad was led by the very talented Jennifer Lipinski and Laura Leacy and Dana Morton, who was named All-Essex County and All-State First Team, and became Bloomfield's first female 1,000-point scorer. He had a remarkable record of 28-4. Overall, White won hundreds of games for Bengals Soccer and Lady Bengals Basketball, with a combined record of 665-251-57.

White taught physical education and health, and drivers' education, and was a mentor to generations of students. He is a member of the BHS Athletic Hall of Fame and NJSIAA Hall of Fame and was named a Legendary Coach by The Bloomfield Educational Foundation in 2009.

He is survived by his wife of 61 years, Virginia Krauss White; his sons: Robert James (Shelley) White; Jeffrey Scott (Monica) White; John Charles White; and his daughter, Cynthia White Olmsted (William); grandchildren: Kevin, Erick, Aidan, Diane, Daniel and Amber White; Andrew, Zachary and Ethan Olmsted; cousin, Barbara (Gary) Sparta; and nephew, David (Mary Anne) Dunphy.

A Celebration of Life will be held on June 22, 2019 at 3Pm in the BHS gym.
